### **MR. G. H. SAVILL**

The death occurred on Tuesday at his home, Roseleigh Cottage, Church-street, Swanmore, of Mr. George Henry SAVILL, aged 54. Mr. SAVILL was born in Swanmore and lived all his life in the district. He was well respected and hard working citizen and was for 33 years a Borough of Ryde ticket collector on the Pier. In his youth he was apprenticed to the printing trade at the "Isle of Wight Times" offices. He was one of the founders of, and trustees of the Paxton Boys' Club, and was a valued member of the Oddfellows and the local branch of the British Legion.

A lifelong member of St. Michael's Church he was for many years a Sunday School superintendant, and his passing is a loss to the town he served both as a servant and a citizen, and the many people who were proud to call him friend will deeply regret his loss. Sympathy is expressed with the widow, two sons and a daughter who are left to mourn him.
