Mr. G. H. SHAWYER.- For many years a trustee and senior society steward of Binstead Methodist Church. Mr. George Henry SHAWYER, of 2 Myrtle Cottages, Newnham Road, died on Thursday at Wilton, near Salisbury. He was 76. Mr. SHAWYER joined the Royal Hampshire Regiment in 1915 and saw service in India, Palestine, France and Germany. On leaving the army in 1919 he began work as a porter with Messrs. BOOTS, chemists, at Ryde, and was with the firm for more than 20 years. He was recalled to the Hampshire Regiment in 1939 and served locally until invalided out in 1942. Mr. SHAWYER was then employed by the late Mr. Alfred CLEAVER, of Newnham Lodge, until his retirement in 1953. Mr. SHAWYER celebrated his golden wedding in 1963. His wife died recently. Mr. SHAWYER was a member of Ryde British Legion. A service on Monday at Binstead Methodist Church, conducted by the minister, the Rev. Harold Deaths BRANDON, preceded interment at Binstead cemetery.
