We regret to announce the death of Miss **Annie Mary Hodson STURDEE**, of the Strand, Ryde, which occurred on Sunday in her 80th year. - Miss STURDEE was the elder daughter of the late Captain George STURDEE, R.N., and sister of the late Admiral F. C. Doveton STURDEE, who will be remembered as the victor of the Battle of the Falklands, early in the War when VON SPEE's Squadron was destroyed.

She was well known in Ryde and also on the Southern Railway steamers on which she travelled every day to do her shopping in Portsmouth. The number of her acquaintances on the boat was remarkable, and her favourite recreation in Portsmouth was to sit among the children at cinema matinees.

The funeral took place on Wednesday, a requiem mass being conducted at St. Mary's Catholic Church by Canon S. MONGAN.
