Mr. **Percy Wilfred SUTTON** of 3 Longmead Road, died at the Royal I.W. County Hospital on Friday, aged 79. A widower, his wife having died in 1960, he was employed for many years at the County Hospital and drove their first motor ambulance in 1911. Mr. SUTTON was a member of the Royal Ancient Order of Buffaloes and was a trustee there from 1925 to 1960. He was also secretary of the Clarence Lodge for 36 years. Mr. SUTTON was a well known billiards and snooker player in the South Coast Billiards League, and a founder member and past treasurer of the Ryde Social Club.

The funeral service at Binstead Chapel yesterday conducted by the Rev. ATTRILL, of Ryde, preceded interment. Family mourners included Mr. W. W. SUTTON, son ; Mrs. E. CHEVERTON, daughter; Mr. W. M.
