## WILL OF THE HON. H.P. VEREKER

The Hon. **Henry Prendergast VEREKER**, of The Pitts, Binstead, who died on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, a son of the third Viscount GORT, left an estate, the value to which amounts to £45,077. Subject to the life interest of his widow, he appointed the funds of his marriage settlement to his children Charles Granville, Henry Gossett, Kathleen Louisa, Alianora Maria Julia, and Elizabeth Henriqua, the share of each son to be double that of each daughter. He gave the household furniture to his wife; an old Berlin candelabra, with paintings of Frederick the Great and the Queen, to Earl GRANVILLE; and various gifts of plate, jewels etc., to his children and the members of the GORT family. His residuary estate he left to his children, his sons taking a double share in relation to that of his daughters.
