SUICIDE. - A coroner's inquest was held at Mr. SWEETMAN's George-street, on Friday afternoon, on the body of Mr. **G.W. WEBB**, whose decease we recorded on Saturday's paper. Mary WEBB, his daughter, described the circumstances under which the deceased was found at 7 o'clock that morning, lying on the scullery floor with his throat cut, and a razor at his back. He had threatened to make away with himself. Evidence was given of the melancholy condition of the deceased previous to the sad occurrence.

The Coroner briefly summed up the evidence, and, after a short interval, the jury returned a verdict of "Temporary insanity."
