Weeks, of the Canadian Scottish Regiment, of Vancouver. The deceased who was well-known and very popular in his native town, after serving an apprenticeship with Mr. Gustav Mullins, emigrated to Canada where he became a partner in the firm of Messrs. Dunne and Weeks photographic stores, Vancouver. He served with the South African Light Horse in the war in South Africa and retired with the rank of Squadron Sergeant-Major.
