We regret to report the death of Mr. Frank WHITE, which took place on Sunday week at Sandbrook Villa, Surrey Street, Ryde. Mr. WHITE, who was 45, entered the employment of the late Mr. W. DORE, house furnisher, when he left school, and became manager of the establishment. A keen sportsman, he was a member of the old Ryde Thursday Athletic team, and an enthusiastic supporter of the Ryde Football Club.
