A post mortem examination is being held and the funeral will probably be on Saturday at Holy Trinity Church prior to interment.

**Lifelong Resident**

Mr. WILLETT was born in Alfred Street and throughout his life was a self-employed man, following various occupations. During the war he worked at SAUNDERS-ROE, Cowes, and for the past three years, with his wife, ran a greengrocery business at 1 St. John's Hill, which the family are now giving up.

Mr. WILLETT, who also leaves three sons, was a committee member of the Isle of Wight Coursing Club and a member of Ryde Old Time Dancing Circle.
