### **MILITARY FUNERAL**

The funeral took place with military honours on Monday afternoon, of Mr. **Walter WILLIAMS**, late of the 20th Hussars. He was manager of a Trust House at Welywyn, Herts. and came to the Island suffering as a result of being gassed while serving in France. The coffin was covered with the Union Jack over which were laid many floral tributes. The band of the 18th Royal Ulster Rifles, from Parkhurst, attended, and a firing party was provided by the same regiment. The first portion of the service was held at All Saints, the Vicar, the Rev. Hugh LE FLEMING, M.A., officiating there and at the graveside.

Mr. E.CHANDLER had charge of the funeral arrangements.
