News has reached Ryde this week that W. M. Wolfe, of the 1/8 Hants, was killed in action in Egypt on April 19th. He was formerly employed as a letter carrier at the Ryde Post Office, and joined the Isle of Wight Rifles in 1914 soon after the outbreak of war. He leaves a widow and child with whom much sympathy is felt.
