FIFTY YEARS IN THE DAIRY BUSINESS.- Mrs. **Ellen YOUNG**, of 15 Quarry Road, who died on Thursday week, aged 86, had been engaged for 50 years in the dairying business when she retired in November. She was a native of Itchenstoke, near Winchester. Mrs. YOUNG at one time owned a herd of cattle, but her meadows gradually became allotments and housing estates, and latterly she had been a distributor for the Milk Marketing Board. Her husband died in November, 1941, nine months after they had celebrated their golden wedding.
