MEMORIAL SURVEY

The suggested route for the Memorial Survey in the Old Cemetery is indicated by the black arrows on the Map on the next page.

The object of the exercise is for the children to walk around the area and record the numbers of the different types of memorials they see.

Three sheets for recording the numbers of the different types of Memorials can be downloaded and printed separately.

The major types of Memorials are shown on two sheets so that the children will know the names of the various types and will not have to sketch them. There are, however, blank sections where they can sketch and record any other types of memorial that they see if they want to.


All the children could be provided with both sheets or half the children with Sheet 1 and the other half with Sheet 2. This way a wider range of Memorial types would be recorded.

If it is preferred the Sheet 3 can be used where children will have to sketch all the Memorials they record.


The types of Memorials and numbers recorded can then be entered into Microsoft Excel and printouts and charts can be produced.




Children should be reminded of the tally method of recording items in fives, shown below, to speed up addition.




MEMORIAL SURVEY MAP
