Hazards	Risk	Risk control measures		
Remote Working	Injury, illness or incident	<ul> <li>A mobile phone must be carried by member of staff leading the group</li> <li>Group leader must have list of all pupils on the trip with their emergency contacts</li> <li>Group leaders should each carry a whistle</li> <li>A first aid kit must be carried by member of staff leading the group (First Aid Kit also available in Learning Centre)</li> <li>Any prescribed medication e.g.inhalers, epipens, with child if usually responsible or designated member of staff</li> <li>Designated access and alternative access points to be known by staff leader</li> <li>Ratio of adults to children to be at least 1:6 for under 5s, 1:8 for 5-8 yr olds and 1:10 for 8-12s (Check current H &amp; S policy guidelines).</li> <li>Route taken should be appropriate for age and ability of group and should be checked before group arrives</li> <li>Ensure group behaviour and supervision is acceptable and appropriate.</li> </ul>		
Falling branches/Trees	Death or major injury	<ul> <li>Verbal warning of risk</li> <li>Routes/ locations for activities to be carefully checked before group arrives</li> <li>Activities to be cancelled in extreme/ potentially dangerous conditions</li> </ul>		
Unstable headstones, railings, grave monuments and surrounds	Fall, minor or major injury	<ul> <li>Verbal warning of risk</li> <li>NO leaning on headstones, railings or grave monuments</li> </ul>		
Contact with micro- organisms (e.g. E. Coli, Weil's disease, Toxicara)	Minor/ serious illness	<ul> <li>Health and safety briefing to include importance of not putting hands near mouths</li> <li>Hand cleaning facilities to be available at all times</li> <li>Hand cleaning to take place before eating and drinking</li> <li>Any open wounds to be protected before activities handling water or soil</li> <li>Careful working practices to be demonstrated and reinforced</li> <li>Warnings about dog mess (also bird &amp; fox mess)</li> </ul>		
Traffic	Death or major injury	Verbal warning of risk, traffic may come along main carriageway		

Lowbranches/bramble/scrub etc. along footpaths	Minor Injury	<ul> <li>Keep to main paths</li> <li>Appropriate clothing to be worn- details included in pre- visit information</li> <li>Verbal warning of risk</li> </ul>
Litter	Minor injury or serious illness	<ul> <li>Litter picking to be carried out regularly</li> <li>Litter bins to be used</li> <li>Areas where groups will be working should be checked on morning of visit</li> </ul>
Poisonous/ harmful animals	Minor/ major injury/ death	<ul> <li>Verbal warning of risks as appropriate</li> <li>Exercise caution when approaching known sites for adders</li> <li>Advise the wearing of 'closed' shoes, long sleeves and trousers</li> <li>Avoid working in areas where there are known bee/ wasp nests</li> </ul>
Poisonous plants/ fungi	Minor/ major illness, death	Verbal warning of risk
Contact with Dogs	Minor/ major injury/ death	Health and safety briefing to include importance of not approaching dogs     Verbal reminders of risk
Extreme weather conditions	Sunstroke/ sunburn/ dehydration	<ul> <li>Ensure group have access to fluids and drink breaks</li> <li>Avoid prolonged exposure to sun</li> <li>Ensure pre visit information includes importance of wearing hats and sunscreen and promote the application of it during the day</li> <li>Modify/ shorten session as necessary</li> </ul>
Extreme weather conditions	Hypothermia	<ul> <li>Ensure pre visit information includes information about importance of warm layers of clothing</li> <li>Modify/ shorten or consider cancelling activities in bad weather</li> <li>Increase use of classroom in Learning Centre in bad weather</li> <li>Provide extra clothing as necessary</li> <li>Be aware of the level of comfort in the group and avoid pro-longed periods of inactivity</li> </ul>
Use of equipment/ tools	Major/minor injury	<ul> <li>Health and safety briefing to include safe handling of any tools and equipment</li> <li>Ensure calm, orderly behaviour and good listening</li> <li>Ensure safe practice is followed</li> <li>Activity to cease in the event of unacceptable behaviour</li> <li>Tools should be checked each time they are used</li> <li>Potentially dangerous tools should be securely stored</li> </ul>
Moving heavy or awkward objects	Injury	Limit size of log/ or tin etc. appropriate to the ability of the participant and use as many people as appropriate to the size of the object

General public	Physical/ verbal abuse/ abduction of children/	<ul> <li>Staff/ volunteers to be recognisable by logos on clothing</li> <li>Regular headcounts</li> <li>Defined boundaries for activities</li> <li>Staff to be vigilant - politely ask members of the public to leave work area if necessary</li> <li>Front and back markers to be designated with each group</li> <li>Attempt to de-escalate any potentially confrontational situation if safe to do so</li> <li>Be prepared to remove group to alternative area if necessary</li> <li>Follow serious incident procedures and notify police if appropriate</li> </ul>
Separation of group member from group	Getting lost	<ul> <li>Regular headcounts</li> <li>Guidelines given to children about what to do if separated</li> <li>Ensure participants let leader know if they are leaving the group early</li> <li>Clear boundaries for activities</li> <li>Ensure good behaviour</li> <li>In the event of unacceptable behaviour, consider shortening sessions</li> <li>Leader at front plus back marker when moving between activities</li> <li>Follow lost child procedure</li> </ul>
