Death of Mr. N.G. BISHOP. – After a long illness the death took place on Sunday of **Mr.** Norman George BISHOP, son of Mr. and Mrs. S. BISHOP, of 51 Park-road. Deceased, who was only 23 years of age, was a young man of high character and engaging personality. Before his illness he took a great interest in the work of St. John's Church, where he was a server and Sunday-school teacher. He was also much interested in sport and was a member of the Paxton Junior Club and St. John's Church Club. Sincere sympathy is felt for the parents and his brothers and sisters.

The Rev. W. Neville MARTIN (vicar of Ryde) conducted the funeral at St. John's Church on Thursday. The choir attended and, with Mr. R.H. TOOGOOD at the organ, led the singing of "Peace, perfect peace," and the chanting of Psalm 23. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. S. BISHOP (father and mother), Mr. and Mrs. G. BISHOP (brother and sister-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. W. BUTCHERS (brother-in-law and sister), Mr. H. BISHOP (uncle), Mesdames PHILLIPS and HAYES (aunts), Mr. W. COGGER (uncle), Miss A. COGGER (cousin), Miss RIVERS (fiancée), Mr. E. ORGAN (employer), and Miss COLLYPRIEST. The interment was at Ryde Cemetery. There were 45 wreaths, including tokens from the servers of St. John's Church, the teachers and kindergarten of St. John's Sunday-school, Messrs. ORGAN, and fellow employees of Messrs ORGAN.
