War Veteran's Death - Mr. Reginald BLISSETT, aged 74, of 76 West Street, died at his home on Monday. A native of Portsmouth, he served throughout the 1914-18 war with the Royal Sussex Regiment, and was discharged in 1919. He came to Ryde some 30 years ago and worked for Messrs. COLNUTT as a grocery assistant, and also, for four years, in the pathological department at the Royal I.W. County Hospital.
