The death occurred at Mont Carmel, Corbett-Road, the residence of her daughter, Mrs. Walter DAY on Sunday of Mrs. **Susan HARMSWORTH**, widow of the late Mr. Edward HARMSWORTH, of Mount-Street. The deceased lady was in her 92nd year, lead a very quiet retiring life and took no part in the local affairs of the town of which she was a native. Her husband pre-deceased her last Easter. She had five children, three daughters and two sons, both of whom are dead, one being killed in the war. The funeral took place on Wednesday.
