Lot 362, a pair of small engravings by BARTOLOZZI, fetched 6½ guineas, and another pair, by the same artist, 4½ guineas. There was a brisk competition for the collection of old china, as well as for the silver plate, some of which realized as much as 27s. an ounce.
