Farm Labourer's Sudden Death.- Mr. **Arthur George TAYLOR**, aged 40, a farm labourer, of Little Upton Farm, died suddenly on Sunday at his home. After having supper, he went outside to watch the searchlights and complained of feeling unwell. He returned indoors and fell asleep in a chair. At about 11.30 p.m. his wife, who had gone upstairs, heard the children, who were sleeping downstairs because of the air raids, call out that their father had fallen on the floor. She found him bleeding from the mouth. Dr. SHANKS was summoned, but on arrival pronounced that life was extinct. The facts were reported to the Acting Coroner (F. A. JOYCE, Esq.), who ordered a post mortem.
