**Bandmaster Bereaved.** - The death occurred at the Royal I.W. County Hospital on Friday week of **Mrs. Florence HAYLES**, aged 72 of 8 Park Road, wife of Mr. R.H. HAYLES, bandmaster of the Ryde Borough Band. Mrs. HAYLES came to the town from Taunton, Somerset, in 1917. She had worshipped at the Salvation Army Citadel for many years and had also been a member of the Baptist Women's League.
