A Sad Bereavement. – The death occurred with tragic suddenness on Christmas-eve of Miss Kathleen Rose Mary HUNNYBUN, fourth daughter of Mr. and Mrs. F. HUNNYBUN of 52 George-street. Deceased went into the County Hospital after six week's illness to undergo an operation. She was to have spent Christmas at home and her sister, Miss Norah HUNNYBUN, arrived at the hospital to fetch her. She had dressed and was just about to step into the taxi when she collapsed and was taken back into the hospital, but died within a few minutes. A post-mortem revealed that a clot of blood on the lung had caused her death, and an inquest was dispensed with. Deceased had been employed as a domestic servant.

The funeral was on her 23rd birthday, on Thursday. A service was conducted at the Salvation Army Citadel, prior to the interment in the cemetery. Major MILLER officiated, and the hymns sung were "Rock of Ages" and "Jesu, Lover of my soul."

The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. F. HUNNYBUN (parents), Messrs. E.F. and W. HUNNYBUN (brothers), Mrs. FOX, Mrs. WINTER, and Miss RUTH, Miss E., and Miss N. HUNNYBUN (sisters), Mr. W. FOX (brother-in-law), Mr. W. DAVIS and Mr. E. HUNNYBUN (uncles), Mr. and Mrs. W. HUNNYBUN (uncles and aunt), and Mrs. W. COGGER (aunt). The floral tributes included one from friends at Yelf's.
