DEATH OF MR. F. J. ROGERS OF YARMOUTH

The death occurred at Victoria-road, Yarmouth, early yesterday (Friday) morning, of Mr. Frederick John ROGERS, aged 70, relieving officer and registrar of births, marriages, and deaths for the West Wight district from 1910 until his retirement in July last. He was a Ryde man, who throughout his adult life had been prominently associated with football and other sport and horticulture. He was a vice-president of both the Hampshire and I.W. Football Associations, a football referee for many years, and a former keen player for the Totland Bay cricket and bowling clubs. A keen horticulturist, he specialised in sweet-peas, for which he won many prizes, including national honours, some years ago.

He leaves a widow, with whom much sympathy is felt.
