

Death of Mr. W. J. GREEN.- We regret to record the death in poignant circumstances on Wednesday of Mr. William John GREEN, of 18 Bellevue-road. Mr. GREEN, who was 63, collapsed whilst at work on Friday morning and did not regain consciousness. He was one of the best known figures in Cross-street, where he had been employed for over 40 years, first with the late Mr. Ernest GROVES and since 1917 as shop manager for Messrs. R. RUSSELL and Sons. He was an expert at his vocation and was held in the highest esteem by those with whom he was brought into daily contact. A few months ago he received the news that his eldest son was missing whilst serving in the Merchant Navy. He has a married daughter and a younger son, with his widow deep sympathy is felt. The funeral takes place in Holy Trinity Church on Monday.
