Mr. P. WALKER,- Member of an old Nettlestone family, Mr. Phil WALKER died at his home, 17 Riboleau Street, on Sunday, at the age of 64. Mr. WALKER who went out with his brother, Mr. J. WALKER, on Saturday evening, retired to bed at 10.15 p.m. and died four hours later. A post mortem revealed that death was through natural causes. Before the first world war Mr. WALKER was an agricultural worker, and after serving several years with the I.W. Territorials took up employment as a shipyard worker at East Cowes, where he had worked ever since. He was a skilled darts player. Mr. WALKER is survived by his brother Mr. J. WALKER, a stepsister, Mrs. A. W. HOBBS, and stepbrother, Mr. P. WALKER.

The funeral takes place at Ryde Cemetery to-day (Thursday), a report of which will appear in our next issue.
