The Late Mr C. GOUGH.-The funeral of Mr. Charles GOUGH, of High-street, whose death occurred on Friday week, took place on Monday. A service was held at St. James's Church where the deceased had been a sidesman for very many years, the incumbent (the Rev. G. C. RUBIE) officiating. Mr GOUGH had been a harness maker and saddler in High-street for a long period, and although well advanced in years, he attended to business until within a few days of death. In former years he managed the harness and saddlery department of the late Mr F. CARTER's posting establishment. He was one of the oldest members of the Y.M.C.A.
