## MR. ALFRED BURMAN

**Two Sudden Deaths.**- The deaths of two residents took place suddenly this week. On Tuesday Mr. Alfred BURMAN, of No. 2 Ashey-cottages, Ashey-road, was taken to St. Mary's Infirmary at Parkhurst.

His departure distressed his wife, Mrs Alice BURMAN, but later in the day she told a neighbour that she felt a little more reconciled. Next morning, however, Mrs BOARD, a neighbour, went to the back of the house and found the door open. Getting no reply to her knocking she entered the house and on going to a bedroom saw Mrs. BURNAM in a stooped position between the bed and the fireplace. She was fully clothed and apparently dead. Dr. BURTON was at once sent for, but could only confirm that life was extinct. Deceased, who was 65 years of age, was handicapped by partial blindness.

After *post mortem* examination, an inquest was deemed unnecessary.
