**Death of Mrs. J. DIBBENS.** - The funeral took place on Friday week of Mrs. Lily Louise DIBBENS, aged 74, of 11a Lower Bettesworth Road, who died at her home the previous Tuesday. A native of Wiltshire, she came to the Island with her husband at the outbreak of the first world war, following their marriage at Warminster in 1906. Mrs. DIBBENS was a member of the British Legion women's section and the Zion Chapel. Her husband, Mr. J. DIBBENS, died in 1955, and she is survived by five sons and two daughters.

The funeral service was conducted by the Rev. H. WRIGLEY (Baptist Church), and Mrs. B. SHACKLETON (organist) accompanied the hymn "Praise, my soul." The interment was in the same grave as her husband at Ryde Cemetery.
