MRS. F. L. HUDSON

For 17 years a die stamper at Osborne's, stationers and engravers, Union Street, Mrs. **Florence Lily HUDSON**, of 23 Daniel Street, died on Tuesday of last week at the home of her only son, Mr. K. E. PIDWELL, of 39 Prince Street. Her death followed a collapse at work. Mrs. HUDSON, who had many friends in Ryde, was a native of Cornwall and came to Ryde in 1936. Her first husband died in 1938, and she re-married in 1941. Her second husband was killed in a motor accident at Dover while serving in the Army shortly after the war. In addition to her son, Mrs. HUDSON leaves one sister, Mrs. A. BLACKBURN.

The funeral service took place on Friday at Holy Trinity Church when the Vicar, the Rev. H. E. GIBSON, officiated. Mourners were Mr. and Mrs. K. E. PIDWELL, son and daughter-in-law; Mrs. A.
