Mrs. Y. V. MEREDITH.- Mrs. Yvonne Violet MERDITH, formerly of Binstead Hill, Binstead, and Duxmore Farm, Havenstreet, has died at The Pines Nursing Home, Totland, aged 82. She was born at St. Helens into a large family. Her father was a sea captain and her grandparents ran the Lifeboat Inn at Bembridge. She was widowed twice. She farmed with her first husband, Mr. Herbert MEREDITH, at Duxmore Farm, until his death in 1929, and continued to farm herself until her remarriage in 1959. She then moved to Toronto, Canada, with her second husband, Mr. William MEREDITH (her former husband's brother). She returned to the Island in 1961 after her second husband's death, and lived at Binstead Hill, Binstead, until three years ago when she moved to The Pines Nursing Home, Totland.
