## **DEATH OF MRS. E. G. STAYNER**

The funeral took place at All Saints' Parish Church on Saturday of Mrs. Ella Gordon STAYNER, widow of Lieut.-Col. L. G. STAYNER, formerly of Ellerslie, Ashey Road, Ryde.

Mrs. STAYNER died at Newport on Wednesday week at the age of 71. A daughter of Col. PILKINGTON-WHITE, she trained for the nursing profession at St. Thomas's Hospital, London, and during the first world war took duties at the Salisbury Hospital, being awarded the R.R.C.

Later she became matron of the COUNTESS of RADNOR's war-time hospital at Longford Croft, Salisbury.

While living in Ryde Mrs. STAYNER was a member of the Royal Victoria Yacht Club and the Lawn Tennis and Croquet Club. For a time she was hon. secretary of the Isle of Wight Rescue and Preventive Society. In the last war she again helped with Red Cross work and with the W.V.S.
