Mrs. PAGE was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. C. KELLEWAY, formerly of the same address, and wife of the late Mr. Sidney PAGE, who predeceased her some two years ago. She was well known and highly esteemed in the neighbourhood in which she lived and her passing will occasion widespread regret amongst her large circle of friends. She had been a member of the Ryde Co-operative Women's Guild for a number of years.

Following a funeral service at St. John's Church, the interment took place at Ryde Cemetery on Monday, at which the mourners were Mrs. E. WELSH (sister), Messrs. Charles, Fred, Ernest and Edward KELLEWAY (brothers), Mr. W. WRIGHT (brother-in-law), Mesdames A., E., and M. KELLEWAY (sisters-in-law), Mrs. C. ATTRILL, Mrs. K. WHITE (nieces), and Mrs. K.
