**DEATH OF MRS. E. J. QUARRIER**

The death occurred at Olverne, Newnham Road, on Sunday, of Mrs. Edith Jane QUARRIER, widow of Mr. G. QUARRIER, aged 81. Mrs. QUARRIER was a native of Cornwall, and her first husband was the late Mr. E. TRIGGS. In 1932 she married Mr. QUARRIER as his second wife, and, until his retirement in 1942, assisted him in the running of Roach's Hotel, then in St. James's Square, Newport. In 1942 Mr. and Mrs. QUARRIER settled in Ryde. Mrs. QUARRIER made her home at Binstead after her husband's death.

The funeral took place at the Methodist Church on Thursday. The Rev. T. J. FOINETTE officiated and the hymn "When I survey" was sung. The mourners were: Col. M. J. WILLIAMS (nephew), Mrs. TROUNSON (niece), Mr. T. H. WILLIAMS (cousin), Mr. and Mrs. J. A. QUARRIER (brother-in-law and sister-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. COLLYER, the Misses HILL and E. JAMES and Mr. H.
