Mr. E. ROBINSON. – Landlord of the “Nag’s Head” until a year ago, Mr. Edward ROBINSON, of The Flat, East Street, died at St. Mary’s Hospital, Newport on Monday, aged 68. Mr. ROBINSON came to Ryde in 1946 from Plymouth after serving 21 years in the Royal Marines, later working as a dockyard policeman. He leaves a widow, a son and two daughters.
