SERVED IN THE CANADIAN ARMY.- The funeral took place on Monday of **Mr. Arthur Herbert BRIDLE**, aged 84, of 87, High Park Road, who died at Whitecroft Hospital on Wednesday week. He was born on the Appley estate, where his father was head gardener for many years, and at the age of 18 enlisted in the Royal Hampshire Regiment. He went to Canada and later joined the Canadian Army, retiring with the rank of staff sergeant after 20 years' service. He returned to his native town and was employed on the outside staff of the island electricity undertaking. His work included supervising the building of the pylons on the top of St. Boniface Down.

The Rev. A. HOUGH officiated at the funeral at Ryde Cemetery. The mourners were Mrs. BRIDLE (widow), Mrs. P. BROWN (daughter) and Messrs. A. and J. BOYCE (grandsons).
