Nonagenarian's Fall.- On Saturday the Assistant Deputy Coroner (H. R. PALMER, Esq.), held an inquest on Mrs. **Sarah CONNOR**, aged 90, a widow, who had lived at No. 2 Flat, Wyndham House. Mrs. Nina PATTERSON, a niece, with whom deceased resided, said that on the evening of May 18th she left deceased sitting in an arm-chair in the dining-room while she went shopping. On returning half an hour later she found deceased lying on the floor by the side of the chair. She explained that she had fallen between two chairs. Dr. G. A. UPCOTT-GILL said deceased had sustained a fracture of the right thigh, and her death on June 4th resulted from hypostatic pneumonia following the fracture. The Coroner returned a verdict in accordance with the medical evidence.
