FAMILY HISTORY

Elizabeth Lind, (1792-1867) met a Swiss colonel, Antoine Beat Albert du Thon, (Albert) during travels and they were married at St. George's, Hanover Square, London in 1820, then lived in Switzerland with regular long visits to England, until some years after the death of Albert in 1838, who had become a naturalised Englishman. They had four sons, each known by their second name, and they all died young: William Oscar at 19, Edmond at 3 1/2 months, **Jean Rodolfe at almost 16 and Charles Albert at 12**, the latter two both in 1843, at Ryde, Isle of Wight. Their two daughters, Juliette Blanche, (1823-92) and Elizabeth Geraldine, (1832-1921) married brothers Edmund and Samuel Peters. Elizabeth moved to The Lawn after her sister Anne's death in 1861.
