

**Death of Mr. H.C. COX.** - The death occurred on Thursday at Strathleven, West Hill-road, of Mr. **Henry Charles COX**, aged 45. He had been seriously ill for about a fortnight. A London man, he had lived in Ryde for seven years, and throughout the war was employed by Messrs. J. Samuel WHITE at Cowes. Latterly he had worked for Messrs. CHANDLER and Son. He was a keen supporter of the Labour Party and at the general election worked ardently on their behalf. Until his health broke down he served in the Home Guard, and afterwards became a deputy street party leader of the Fire Guard. He was a keen gardener, a great lover of animals, and a football enthusiast. Sincere sympathy is extended to his wife and mother.
