DEATH OF A RYDE SAILOR. - Many will learn with regret of the death, on 2nd of October, of Edward TRUCKELL, a seaman serving on board H.M. ship *Rambler*. It seems while the ship was at Shanghai, China, the deceased was on duty in one of the small boats, when he slipped and fell backwards into the water, and before he could recover himself drifted under the landing stage, and became entangled among the chains, where he was drowned. His body was found about an hour afterwards. The deceased was only 30 years of age, and leaves a widow and two children, for whom much sympathy is felt.

Note: There is some discrepancy whether the surname was TRUCKEL or TRUCKELL. All the siblings found (7) were register as TRUCKEL, but other records varied.
