DEATH OF MRS NAPIER.---We regret to record the death on Friday last, of Mrs NAPIER of Claremont, West Street. Although the infirmities incident to her great age had long kept her retired, Mrs NAPIER never lost her interest in those around her, and was of a most charitable and kindly disposition.

The funeral took place on Wednesday last, at the Old Church, Shanklin, in the family vault, the Rev Barry COLE and the Rev R. HOSGOOD officiated. The outer coffin was of English oak and massive brass, the breast plate bearing the following inscription:

Aged 85 years.
