DEATH OF MR. H.V.R. OSMAN

The Rev. E.E.M. GREEN officiated at the funeral at the cemetery on Monday of Mr. Harold Victor Roper OSMAN, aged 72, of 36 Union Road, who died at his home on Thursday week. A native of the borough, he was the eldest son of the late Mr. and Mrs. H. OSMAN. Apart from the first world war, when he served with the Royal Artillery in both India and France, he had been employed by Messrs. NICHOLSON, the Esplanade, as a photo finisher since 1906. He was a member of the British Legion, who were represented at the funeral. The mourners were Messrs. W.E. and C.C.B. OSMAN (brothers), Mr. F.A. MELLANBY and Mr. G. SAVILL.
