SUDDEN DEATH OF MR. A. G. SUTTON.---On Tuesday morning Mr. Alick G. SUTTON (brother of the late Sir Richard SUTTON) died very suddenly while cruising in Colonel BAGOT's yacht *Creole*, off Cowes. We understand that the deceased gentleman, who was very well known in Ryde, was seized with an attack of apoplexy on Monday, and was atended by Dr. HUGHES, of Cowes, and by the family doctor from Ryde. Nothing could, however, save him, and he died on the following morning between 7 and 8 o'clock. The deceased gentleman was only 29 years of age, and his sudden death has created much sensation, and very much sympathy is expressed for the bereaved family.
