It was thought at one time that an inquest would be necessary, but Dr. DAVEY, who attended, gave a certificate as to the cause of death, and consequently an inquest will be unnecessary.

Mrs. SCOVELL was bound over to keep the peace towards her husband by the borough magistrates a short time since, and we are sorry to say had given way to drinking habits to such an extent as to bring on a disease which terminated in her death on Tuesday.
