Death of Mrs. E. FIELD.- Mrs. Elizabeth FIELD (78), of 115 Arthur Street, died at her home on Saturday after a long illness. She and her husband, who had been married 56 years, came from Cinderford, in the Forest of Dean, 26 years ago, and for several years lived at Sandown. Sixteen years ago they moved to Ryde, where Mrs. FIELD was a former member of the Haylands Women's Institute. She is survived by her husband, three sons and a daughter.

The funeral took place at the Baptist Church on Wednesday, when the Minister (the Rev. Walter FANCUTT) conducted the service and the hymns were "Abide with me" and "Jesu, Lover on my soul." The mourners were Mr. W.
