**DEATH OF MRS. JEFFREYS .-** We regret to record the death on the 8th December, of Mrs. JEFFREYS, of 6, The Terrace, Ryde. To old residents of the town the name of JEFFREYS is a well-known one, for the deceased lady and her husband, the late General E. R. JEFFREYS, C.B., were prominent residents 30 or 40 years ago. Previous to that General JEFFREYS was for some years in command at Parkhurst, and he spent the remainder of his life in the town, residing at Seafield (The Red House as it then was) in Pelham Fields. After his death the widow came to reside at The Terrace. Mrs. JEFFREYS was a Miss Mary Vans AGNEW, of Bambanoch and Shenchon, Wigtownshire. The deceased lady was in her 95th year. The funeral will take place tomorrow, (Saturday), the first portion of the service being at St. Thomas' Church at 1.45.
