**HE WAS CHIEF OF ISLAND "BUFFS"**

**MR. A. N. RUSSELL**

Mr. Alexander Newbury RUSSELL who died at his home, 11 Station Street, Ryde, on Tuesday, held the highest position in the R.A.O.B. movement on the Island. He was the Right Honourable of the Clarence Lodge at the London Hotel, Ryde.

Mr. RUSSELL who was 81, retired during the war after 50 years service with the Southern Railway. He was a fireman and later engineer driver on the Ryde-Ventnor line. For the last few years he had been employed as stoker at Warner's Puckpool Holiday Camp. He is survived by his widow, a son and a daughter.

The funeral will take place at 10.30 a.m. on Saturday at All Saints' Parish Church.
