DEATH OF MR. J. COAPE.- We regret to record the death of Mr. J. COAPE, one of our oldest county magistrates, at the age of 75. The deceased gentleman had resided in the town for a considerable number of years, and was always very attentive to his magisterial duties. He was the father of Lady DALY, and out of respect to his memory the meeting of the Isle of Wight Hunt, which was to have taken place on Monday, was postponed.

The funeral took place on Monday afternoon, when there attended General Sir Henry DALY, Mr. F. White POPHAM, J.P., D.L., Mr. B. BARROW, Mr. W. A. GLYNN, Mr. G. SHEDDEN, Mr. W. H. RADCLIFFE, Mr. J. WILSON FARDELL (clerk to the Justices), Colonel TATTNALL, and Captain F. GREEN. Very beautiful wreaths were sent by Lady and Miss DALY, Miss LEES, Miss Ida LEES, Lady BROWNE, Nurse STEVENSON, and many others. The coffin was of polished elm, with brass mountings.
