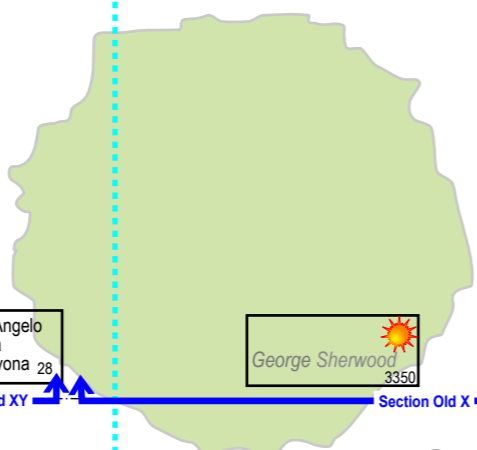
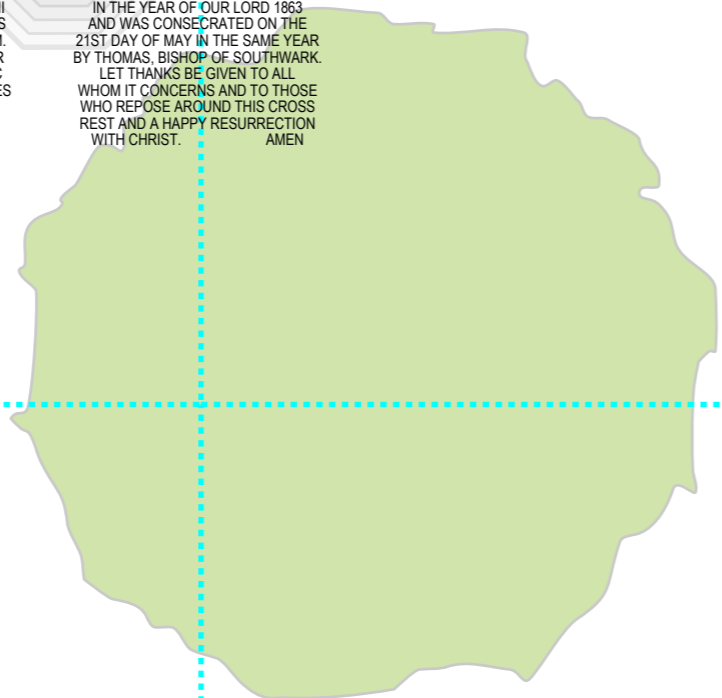


Roman Catholic Section Cross
