Former Carrier's Death. – Mr. Frederick CASS, who has passed away suddenly at Violet Villa, Oakfield, at the age of 74, was for over 40 years a familiar figure here and at Newport Market. During that time he conducted a carrier's business between the two towns. His wife died two years ago after they had celebrated their golden wedding. A family of 10 survive.
