The Late Mr. C.H. BURT. - the funeral of Mr. **Charles Henry BURT**, of 17 Prince-street, took place on Friday week at the cemetery. Mr. BURT, who died on the previous Monday at the age of 74, was a well known and respected inhabitant. In earlier years he joined the 2nd Hants Regiment and later was in the employ of the Southern Railway for 21 years, retiring as a guard nine years ago, since when he had assisted one of the local furniture removers. Familiarly known as "Peter" to his intimates, he was a man with a cheery and considerate nature. Deep sympathy is felt with his widow, who was unable to attend the funeral, and other members of the family.
