SUDDDN DEATH. - The death occurred with painful suddenness on Sunday evening last of Mrs **Prudence JARMAN**, widow, sixty years of age, of 31, Pier Street. The deceased was on her way to attend Holy Trinity Church with her daughter at about half-past six; just before reaching the building she complained of feeling unwell. A chair was procured from the Church, and stimulants were administered. Before the arrival of Dr. TURNER the lady had expired, her death causing a painful sensation amongst the congregation who later learned of the matter. The facts were reported to the Coroner for the Island, but as Dr. PRESTON who was able to certify death from heart failure, had previously attended her, an inquest was deemed unnecessary.
